YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO HAS BEEN DESIGNATED THE FRACKING INDUSTRY'S DUMPING GROUND.

All around our city there are fracking "RESIDUAL WASTE" tanker truck cleaning businesses appearing. Are these the 4,000 jobs, including "INDIRECT" jobs that Chamber of Commerce Pres. Tom Humphries is promoting?

The only jobs we will get are hauling fracking waste by truck, cleaning radioactive, toxic chemicals out of frack waste tanker trucks and going to spill sites to clean up fracking waste water and drilling mud.

These are dangerous jobs that involve handling cancer-causing chemicals and radioactive drilling mud and frack well flowback water.

- <u>EverClear on Oakwood Ave. in Austintown-just</u> outside of Youngstown city limits are cleaning radioactive, toxic fracking waste from tanker trucks
